1. EVALUATION CRITERIA AND METHODOLOGY

This tender was advertised on 01 December 2017. The evaluation criteria and methodology were communicated to all potential service providers as stipulated in the below.

- a) Comply with Regulation 13C of the Public Service Regulations,
- b) Tender prices must remain valid for a period of 90 days (calculating from closing date of bid),
- c) The service provider should have a team of both qualified chartered accountants and engineers with a combined experience of more than five years in water infrastructure accounting of assets or relevant public-sector environment. Certified SAICA and ECSA registration is a requirement.
- d) The 80/20 preference point system as contained in the Preferential Procurement Regulations No R32 of 20 January 2017 (BBBEE) will be used in the adjudication of this tender. Functionality will be evaluated as an eligibility criterion. The eligibility criteria relate to the bidder's ability to provide a quality service to the Overberg Water Board. The Bidder's experience and other criteria will be evaluated. Bidders scoring less than the minimum points will not meet the eligibility criteria and will therefore not be considered for further evaluation. A valid, original Tax Clearance Certificate from the South African Revenue Services must be supplied with the tender document. The service provider should be registered on Central Supplier Database.

2. ADDITIONAL MANDATORY REQUIREMENTS

The tender did not mention all mandatory compliance requirements. **All mandatory requirements mentioned on the tender remains the same.** The following additional mandatory compliance is required:

- Should the potential bidder not qualify as an Exempted Micro Enterprises (EME's) or Qualifying Small Enterprises (QSE's) it is the requirement that the bidder must sub-contract a minimum of thirty percent (30%) of the work to either EME's or QSE's or both.
- In particular, preference shall be given to business entities qualifying as EME's and QSE's.
- ***Service providers who have already submitted the tender need to re-submit again if they were not complying with the above additional requirements.***

3. CLOSING DATE

The closing date for this tender was 05 January 2018 at 12H00. The Overberg Water therefore extends this closing date to **19 January 2018** at 12h00. ***Kindly take note that those service providers who have already submitted the tender need to submit again.***
